The details: OfficeUntitled's design "stressed the fun nature of the challenge," says design director Brooks Atwood, followed by tackling the basic tenets of function and practicality. Case in point: a rotating bed that can also be used as a desk, banquette, sofa, and chaise lounge. Adding to the unique scheme is the bathroom, crafted as a wellness-inspired escape with a curved glass shower, a freestanding clawfoot tub, and acoustical wall treatments.
